MOve Summer Intensive Scholarship Application Summer 2021 Requirements and Procedures

Requirements for Applicants:

Missouri State University Department of Theatre and Dance, and Springfield Ballet have a select number of funds available for tuition, and room and board scholarships for students who:

- Demonstrate a true passion and desire for dance. Recipients who go above and beyond expectations are highly regarded.
- Enroll in MOve summer intensive and attend minimum class requirements as requested by MOve staff and faculty, which will be dependent upon the level and age of the student. Scholarship students must commit to the entire intensive week. If a student leaves during the intensive, their scholarship will be voided and the student will be invoiced for the days in which they attended the program. They will be unable to apply for future summer intensive scholarships.

Procedures for Applicants:

- In order to be eligible for a scholarship award, the applicant must be an incoming 7 12 grader. Scholarship awards are based on a rubric which scores financial need and a written essay. Scholarship awards are decided by a committee of Missouri State University and Springfield Ballet faculty. The scholarship may only be used during the summer 2021 MOve Summer Intensive.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.

- All current Springfield Ballet students must have financial accounts in good standing to be eligible.
